POSITION SUMMARY:

This is a seasonal position at YMCA Camp DeBoer, a camp and conference center located up at beautiful Lake of the Woods. The applicant will assist the Head Cook in preparing and serving nutritious meals to all participant as well as maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of the camp facility.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist in the daily operations of the camp food service.
 - Assist in the preparation of food as the menu indicates.
 - Set up food, supplies, and utensils for dining hall distribution.
 - Store food and leftovers at proper temperature.
2. Assist in routine sanitation of the kitchen and related equipment.
 - Clean and maintain all food-preparation and storage areas.
 - Wash all dishes, serving and preparation equipment, and utensils according to regulated washing methods and temperatures.
 - Reduce waste, reuse items, and recycle as indicated through the camp's procedures.
3. Perform janitorial and general maintenance duties
 - Sweep, scrub, clean floors, wash windows and screens, put up and take down screens and storm windows.
 - Keep shower houses and main lodge bathrooms stocked and clean on a daily basis.
 - Dispose of trash and waste.

QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifications:

- ◆ Desire to work in a food service setting preferred.
 - ◆ Knowledge of food preparation and serving, storage of food and dishwashing procedures preferred.
 - ◆ Must successfully pass criminal background check.
